

## HAVING A CONVERSATION HEART TOWARDS GOD

God's love for us is real and it is committed.

Our love for God should be real and committed as well.

The only meaningful thing that we can give God is ourselves.

The first requirement of discipleship is to spend time with God.

You can give your heart to the Lord day by day, only as you spend time with Him.

King David was a man after God's own heart, meaning David's heart was pointed towards God.

If your heart is pointed towards God, you too can be a man or woman after God's own heart.

Three ways you can point your heart towards God:

1. A heart pointed in God's direction is a heart that prepares.

When is your special time with the Lord?

Have you set a specific time?

If not, it's probably not going to happen.

2. A heart that is pointed in God's direction is a heart that shares.

Nothing you do for God means anything unless it flows out of who you are in Him.

Becoming who you are in Him requires you to be with Him.

3. A heart that is pointed in God's direction is a heart that cares.

If you get to know the Lord, you will care about His sheep.

Because David's heart was pointed in God's direction, David would do whatever God wanted (not the other way around).

God wants His people to know that He loves them and that He loves spending time with them.
