Jesus came to set you free from sin, from ungodly feelings and from heartache, trust Him to do that.

Stand firm! Resist!

If Satan cannot tempt us through the front door with obvious sins, he will try to sneak in through the back door with pride.

He may even get us to think we are good enough to earn our salvation.

Pride is also an ungodly feeling.

The way Jesus resisted temptation was by using the Word of God.

It is impossible to walk by the Spirit of God if you do not know the Word of God.

Read the Word, write the Word (journal), meditate on the Word.

Jesus can help you stand firm, but He can't do it for you.

Feelings follow your thoughts, change your thoughts and you will eventually change your feelings.

Stand firm and resist!
