God DOES have a way for you.

Remember who God is!

He knows what you can and cannot handle.

As we grow in our faith, the path tends to become more and more difficult.

1. God will make a way **to** you.

God had to make a way to us before we could even be saved.

Just because you walk away from God does not mean He stops loving you.

This whole message today is part of God making a way to you.

2. God will make a way **for** you.

If God leads you to it He will lead you through it.

Sometimes God will lead you to the hard thing to take you through the hard thing.

God has made a way for you right now.

3. God will make a way **through** you.

God made a way through Abraham, Joseph, Moses, Joshua and others.

He will make a way through you too.

He will do that through your testimony, even through your weaknesses and failures.

He will make a way through your praise.
