#### GOD DWELLS WITH HIS PEOPLE

God wants to dwell with His people, but there are requirements that have to be met for that to happen.

### God wants to dwell with us (inside of us).

But we must make a place for the Lord to dwell.

But in the new testament God wants to dwell IN us (corporately).

If you have asked Jesus Christ to be your Lord and Savior, God lives inside of you!

## God redeemed you.

There was a tremendous cost for God's plan of redemption.

God paid a great price for us!

There was no way possible for us to pay the price for our salvation, only God could pay the price.

God dwells among us so that we can know Him.

So that we can know His love and then we can trust Him.

When we trust Him, we want to obey Him.

We can never earn our salvation, it's not by works, stop keeping score.

We cannot redeem other people, but God does want us to have a heart for redemption.

## God wants to give us a heart of redemption.

God has a heart of redemption toward us and He wants us to have the same kind of heart toward others.

Having a heart of redemption sometimes comes at great personal expense to us.

God wants us to pay a price of redemption for one another.

The apostle Paul wanted to even know the fellowship of His suffering.

Paul wanted to share in Christ's suffering in order to know Him better.
