

WHERE DO WE GO FROM HERE?

Jesus came into this world with a mission; to seek and save the lost.

We don't truly appreciate being found until we feel lost.

Jesus had to do what we could not do, to pay the price we could not pay.

What He did to seek and save you came at a huge price.

Jesus passed His mission on to His disciples, He co-missioned us.

His mission is now our mission.

Many of us feel that if we are not doing something all the time we are wasting time.

We may even feel like we need to be doing multiple things at once.

Jesus' last command to His disciples before He left the earth was to "wait."

Most of us feel that if we are waiting, we are wasting time.

The greek word here for wait is perimenó (Strong's Greek 4037) pronounced per-ee-men'-o.

It is a verb which means to stay around.

God wants us to stay around His presence.

Being baptized in the Holy Spirit is not just a one time experience, we need to abide in Him.

We need to stay around His presence, wait on Him, be with Him.

Otherwise we can do nothing.

Do you sometimes feel like your strength is gone?

How much have you been waiting on the Lord?

To wait means to be with Him, stay around Him, to be without an agenda.

When we read the Word of God are we doing it to be in His presence or just to gain knowledge.

Be still and know that I am God.

We need to step out of our agenda into God's agenda.

The disciples banded together and there was a sense of unity.

They had fellowship.

They met needs.

But do not band together with an unbeliever.

God wants to stretch us but sometimes we can be stretched to the breaking point.

1. Wait on the Lord.
2. We need to BAND together.

Believe

Assemble (with believers)

Needs (sharing needs appropriately)

Deeds

3. Stretch.
