A good trainer shows a person how to do something, but then gives them the opportunity to do it for themselves, they don't just keep doing it for them.

A good trainer (Mom) reaches out to their children, they are the initiator.

Even if you do not have any children of your own, you can be a spiritual Mom to someone.

We need spiritual Moms, we need surrogate Moms and we need sharing Moms.

Mom that share their lives with others.

We can help correct other inexperienced or untrained Moms.

Moms should do what is best for their children, not what make them comfortable.

Moms are meant to reproduce, they are vital to the reproductive process.

Don't depend upon your own strength, get the nourishment that comes from the Lord.
