

AUTHORITY PART 3 – SPEAK TO YOUR MOUNTAIN

Because Jesus is who he is, we have spiritual authority.

But we forfeit our spiritual authority when we engage in sin.

Jesus came to earth and took back that authority from the devil that man had surrendered by sin.

Jesus now has all authority in heaven and earth and has commissioned us to represent him in this earth.

We have been saved by grace and to be saved means to be rescued.

Jesus is our source, all of our authority comes from him.

When we use the authority that Jesus gave us, we multiply Jesus' effectiveness.

We need to multiply the kingdom of God.

Satan wants to stop you from doing that, either by convincing you that you do not have authority or by compromising your authority through sin.

There are some things that you do not have to ask God for, he has already told us it is his will.

In a sense, that means he has already given it to us.

God speaks of those things that are not yet, as though they already are.

We must know God's will before we can operate in authority.

We must know exactly what we are authorized to do before we can do it.

To know that, we have to be in the word (reading our bible) every day.

Somebody is going to possess what God has given you.

Do you want to possess it or let someone else possess it?

You will probably have to fight to get it though, just because you have the authority doesn't mean there won't be a fight.

Sometimes we need to pray and ask God for things, but other times we need to exercise our authority and dare to possess.

We need to know the difference, God requires us to possess the things he has already given us.

Jesus did not stop and ask his father before he did stuff, he already knew if was his will or not.

There is a difference between asking God to move the mountain and telling the mountain to move.

Faith the size of a mustard seed is sufficient to move a mountain.

If you have enough faith to be saved, then you have enough faith to heal someone.

It's not about the size of the seed, it's a matter of where it's planted.

Your faith needs to be planted in Jesus.

When Jesus talked about moving a mountain, he was not talking about a literal mountain, he was talking about anything in your life that seems large, looming, impossible and/or immovable.

Do you have anything like that in your life?

God will not move the mountain for you if he has commanded you to move it by speaking to it.

The reality in the word of God has to become greater than the reality we see with our physical eyes.

The word of our testimony (in Revelation 12) consists of:

1. The meditation of our hearts.
2. The words of our mouths.
3. Our actions.

Sometimes we give the devil keys to our lives, keys of unforgiveness, bitterness, anger, criticalness, stubbornness, lust, etc.

Take the keys away from the devil!

Secure your spiritual building.

Align yourself with Jesus and speak to the mountains in your life.
